Candidate Filing - April 2023 Election

Filing for the position of Mayor and Alderpersons in Wards 1, 2 and 3 for the April 4, 2023 election will open at 8:00 a.m. on Tuesday, December 6, 2022 and close at 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, December 27, 2022. The minimum age for Mayor is 25, and 18 for the Alderperson position. Candidates may file for office at City Hall during normal business hours, 8:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday.
